Space Requirements:

In registering to buy a space, space holders agree to:

1. Provide an interactive activity or giveaway showcasing your business. These are our youth and your future employees. Let's engage their creativity and show what your business does. For example, we have had mechanics with cutaway motors and architects with model houses and CAD systems, engineers with hot rods.
2. Have a minimum of one person to staff the space at all times. We recommend two people per space given the number of students coming through.
3. Interact with the students. We want to see your passion for your business or industry by interacting positively with students. We want to avoid spaces where the adults just talk to each other and avoid the students.
