SELECTED LAND USE REGISTER AND MOANATAIARI

Reviewing the most recent version of the register, I noticed that there are a variety of classifications and summary headings attached to properties in Moanataiari. However, each appears to be connected to Activity E7 of the Hazardous Activities and Industries List (HAIL).

Activity E7 is:

"Mineral extraction, refining and reprocessing, storage and use -
Mining industries (excluding gravel extraction) including exposure of faces or release of groundwater containing hazardous contaminants, or the storage of hazardous wastes including waste dumps or dam tailings."

Over the course of the Moanataiari project, we have fielded a number of queries from residents, including an email today, questioning the inclusion of the Moanataiari subdivision on the regional selected land use register and its HAIL classification.

To our reading, E7 is not a valid descriptor. Mineral extraction, refining and reprocessing, storage and use by the mining industry did not occur on the Moanataiari subdivision.

If you agree with our reading of E7, please identify what you consider to be a valid descriptor.

On the other hand, if you consider that E7 is a valid descriptor, please explain your reasoning.
